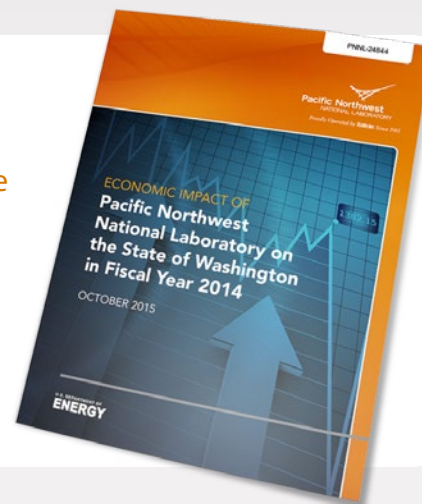


Pacific Northwest National Laboratory – an Economic Engine for Washington State

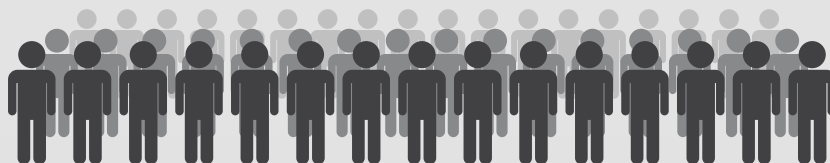

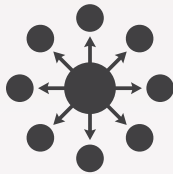
