Summit Topics

- Status reports on codes and standards activities related to hydrogen fuels
- Status reports on safety practices and risk mitigation for insurance coverage
- Status reports on remaining institutional issues and possible responses to them
- Identification of action items and formation of voluntary teams to address them.
