





**Block 14 "DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION," continued.**

- A. Office of Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy (EERE).** This modification is issued to obligate American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009 funds. These funds are made available for the Building Technologies Program Residential Buildings (Project Code 2004060) (**\$650,000**) which is to perform technological assistance for building energy retrofits based on state-of-the-art cost and performance data and a national comprehensive energy efficiency rating system for both residential and commercial buildings. Solid State Lighting (Project Code 2004100) (**\$600,000**) which is for providing technical assistance to EERE for the solid state lighting commercialization needs that would speed the market introduction of new and improved solid state lighting concepts. Funds are also obligated to the Energy Feedstocks Initiative Program (Project Code 2004020) (**\$14,230,000**) which is for the research and development and testing of new bioproducts to be utilized as feedstocks for alternative fuels and materials production. Building and Appliance Market Transformation (Project Code 2004090) (**\$11,470,000**) is to perform a variety of tasks associated with the development of best practices in the commercial industry as well as development of information for the consumers, the development of case studies and analysis to meet market energy reduction goals and to provide technological reviews of proof of concept ideas.

The Recovery Act Project titles are Building Technologies Program Residential Buildings (Project Code 2004060) (**\$650,000**), Solid State Lighting (Project Code 2004100) (**\$600,000**), Energy Feedstocks Initiative Program (Project Code 2004020) (**\$14,230,000**), and Building and Appliance Market Transformation (Project Code 2004090) (**\$11,470,000**). The project codes that should be used to track this Recovery Act funding in the Project section of the Accounting Flex Field in STARS/IDW are 2004060, 2004100, 2004020, and 2004090 accordingly.

- B.** Accordingly, pursuant to Section I, Contract Clause, "Obligations of Funds" and Section B, Contract Clause, B-2, "Obligated Funds", funds in the amount of **\$26,950,000.00** are hereby obligated in support of Recovery Act activities. The total amount of funds obligated under this contract since the inception is increased from **\$12,470,452,174.51** to **\$12,497,402,174.51**.
- C.** The specific work funded by this modification is described in Work Authorization Numbers BT-470006-20742-10, Rev.1 and 3, titled Building Technologies Program Residential Buildings (Project Code 2004060), Work Authorization Number BT-470006-20745-10, Rev.2, titled Solid State Lighting (Project Code 2004100), Work Authorization BM-47006-20852-10, Rev. 0 and Rev. 1, titled Energy Feedstocks Initiative Program (Project Code 2004020) and Work Authorization Number BT-47006-20744-10, Rev 0-9, titled Buildings and Appliance Market Transformation (Project Code 2004090).
- D.** The work described in this modification shall be performed using funds obligated under this contract, which have been appropriated under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, Pub. L. 111-5, and as such, is subject to the special statutory conditions and the additional contractual terms and conditions that were incorporated into the contract at Modification No. A508. The funds obligated hereunder shall only be used to accomplish the work as set forth in paragraph C. above and may not be used for any other purpose without the prior written consent of the Contracting Officer.
- E.** The contractor shall complete all Recovery Act Work funded by this modification in accordance with Recovery Act requirements, including the required completion dates specified therein, and by the completion date identified in the approved work authorization for the activity.
- F.** All other terms and conditions remain unchanged. **[A608]**
