## Next Generation of National Security Leaders

The National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) Graduate Fellowship Program (NGFP) is a premier channel to develop top talent for our nation's critical security missions. The fellowship provides:

- ▶ **Real-world experiences** working in NNSA program and site offices to make programmatic contributions.
- ▶ **Specialized training**, leadership and career development, and networking.

NGFP offers year-long positions annually, in areas of nuclear security and nonproliferation policy and technology, national security research and development, and business and project management.

### PROGRAM BENEFITS

- ▶ Annual Salary (\$80,200 Post Doc or \$68,200 Master's in Progress, Post Master's, or Doctorate in Progress).
- ▶ Hiring incentive (taxed).
- ▶ 3 weeks of vacation annually, accrued weekly.
- ▶ Additional travel and training funding.
- ▶ Annual tuition reimbursement (restrictions apply).
- ▶ Comprehensive benefits package.

### Key Program Dates

- ▶ The application opens **Saturday, August 1, 2026.**
- ▶ Fellowships start June 2027 and go through June 2028.

### PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

- ▶ Candidates must have the ability to obtain a future security clearance, which requires U.S. citizenship for the duration of the one-year fellowship.
- ▶ Be currently enrolled in a graduate degree or doctorate program at the time of application or have graduated within 18 months prior to the application deadline.
- ▶ Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- ▶ Available to work full time for the duration of the one-year fellowship.

PNNL lists the full pay range for the position in the job posting. Positions governed by collective bargaining agreements and certain limited-term positions may have specific pay rules. The full salary range for this position is \$68,200–80,200.
