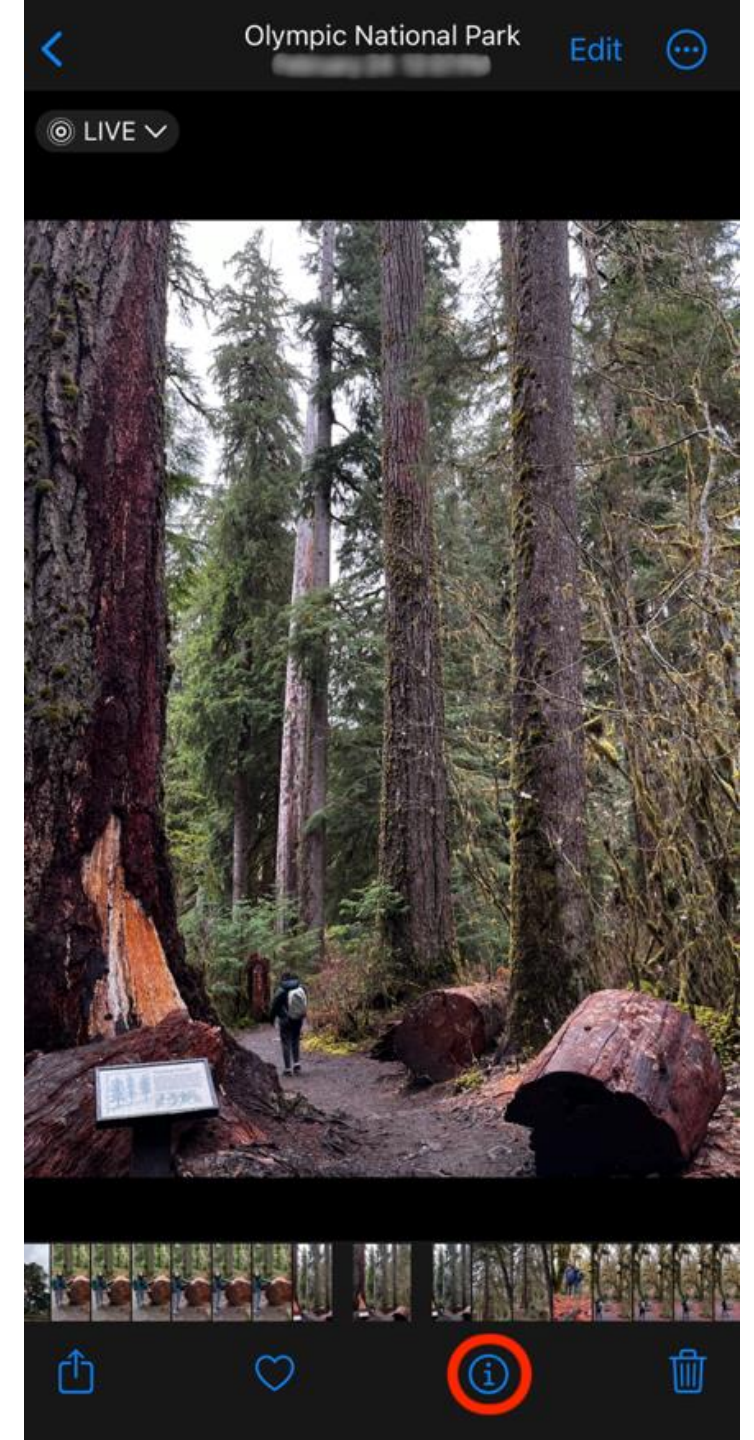


With iOS Smartphones (iPhone) And iOS Tablets (iPads)

To verify that camera location settings have been appropriately configured to capture geotagged photos, the following steps can be followed.

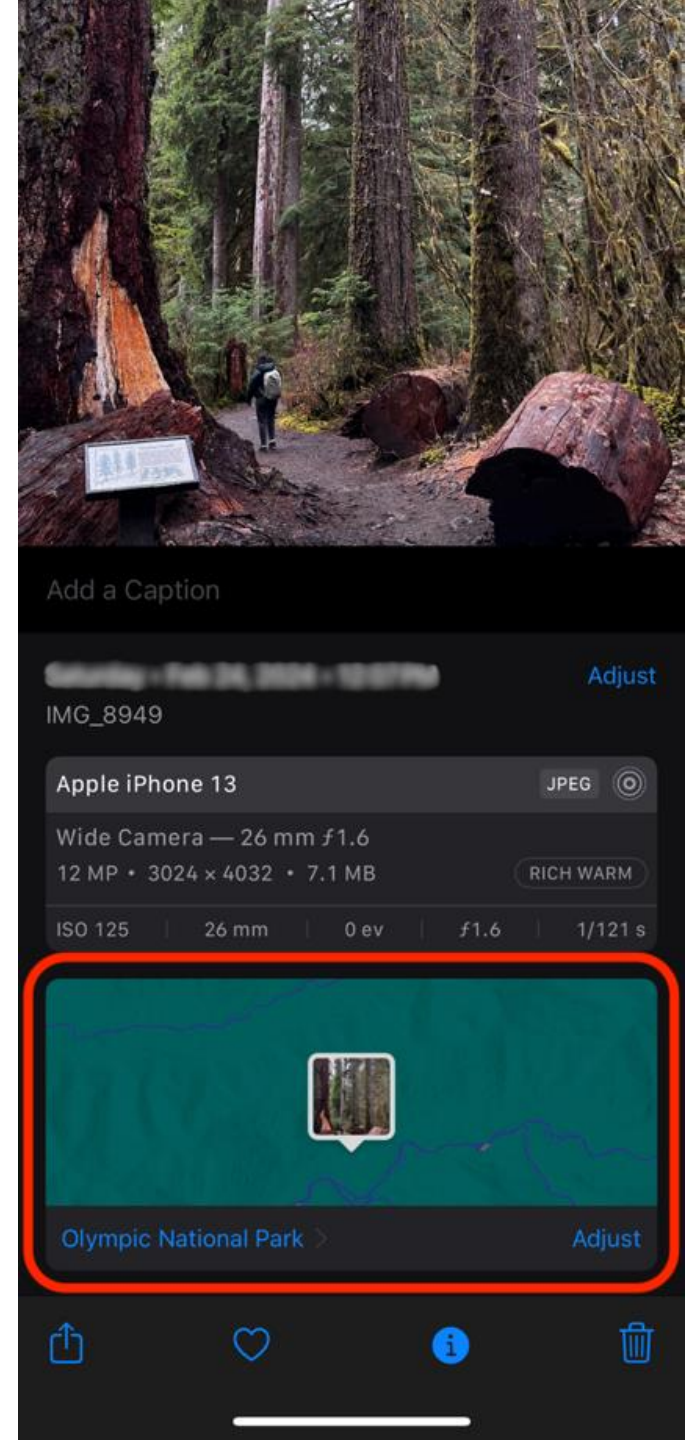
STEP 1 – iOS

Capture a photo with location setting enabled, then navigate to the photo and select the “Information” button on the bottom of the screen.



STEP 2 – iOS

Once the photo's "Information" page is expanded, the geotagged location can be verified.



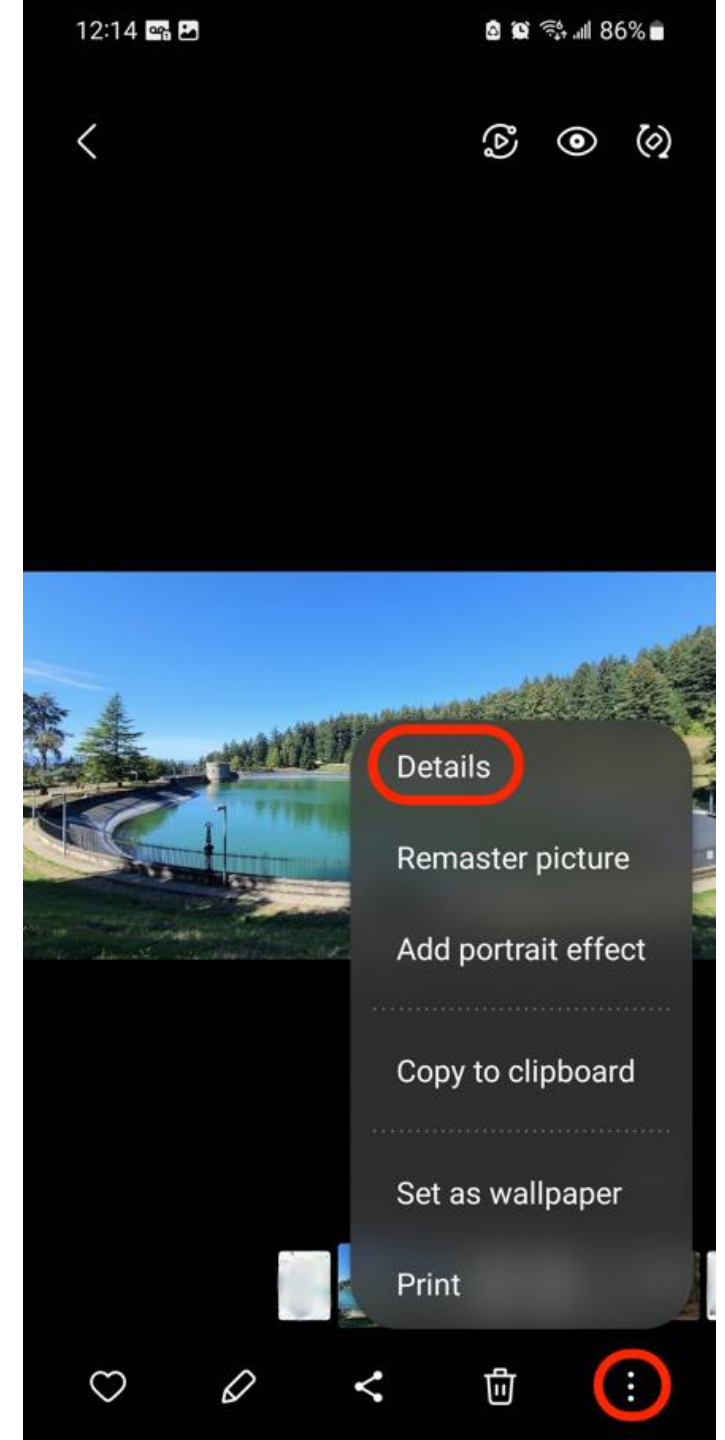


With Android Smartphones and Android Tablets

To verify that camera location settings have been appropriately configured to capture geotagged photos, the following steps can be followed.

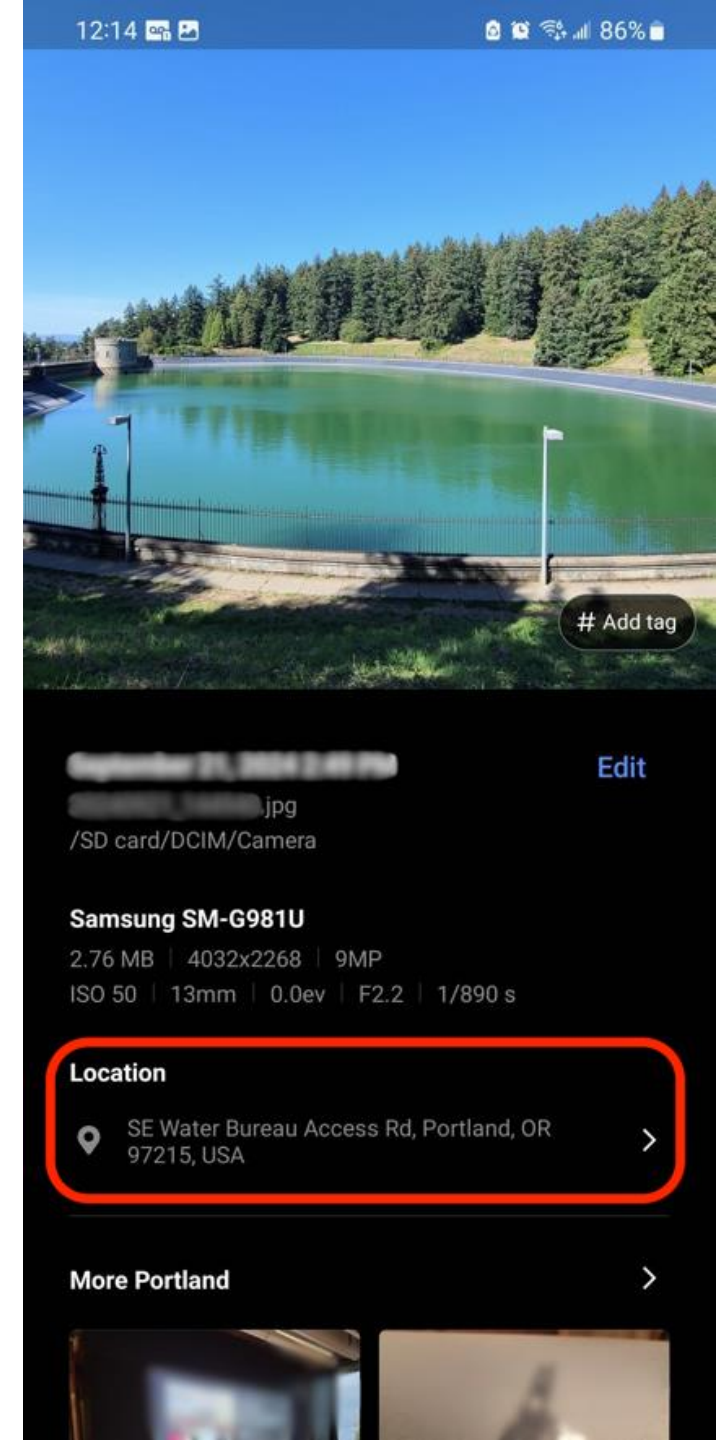
STEP 1 – ANDROID

Capture a photo with location setting enabled, then navigate to the photo and select the more information ellipses on the bottom of the screen.



STEP 2 – ANDROID

Once the photo's "Information" page is expanded, the geotagged location can be viewed.



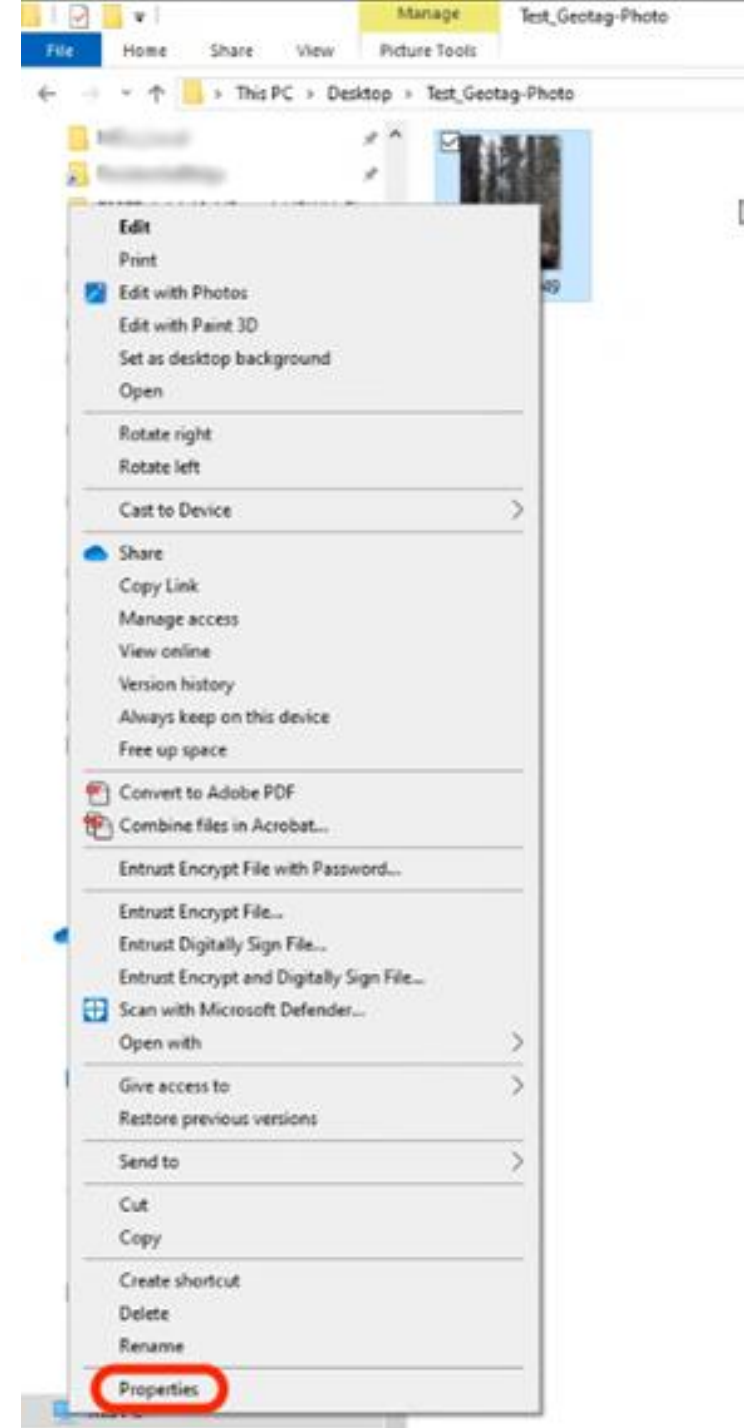


With Windows Computers

To view geotag data of downloaded photos, the following steps can be followed.

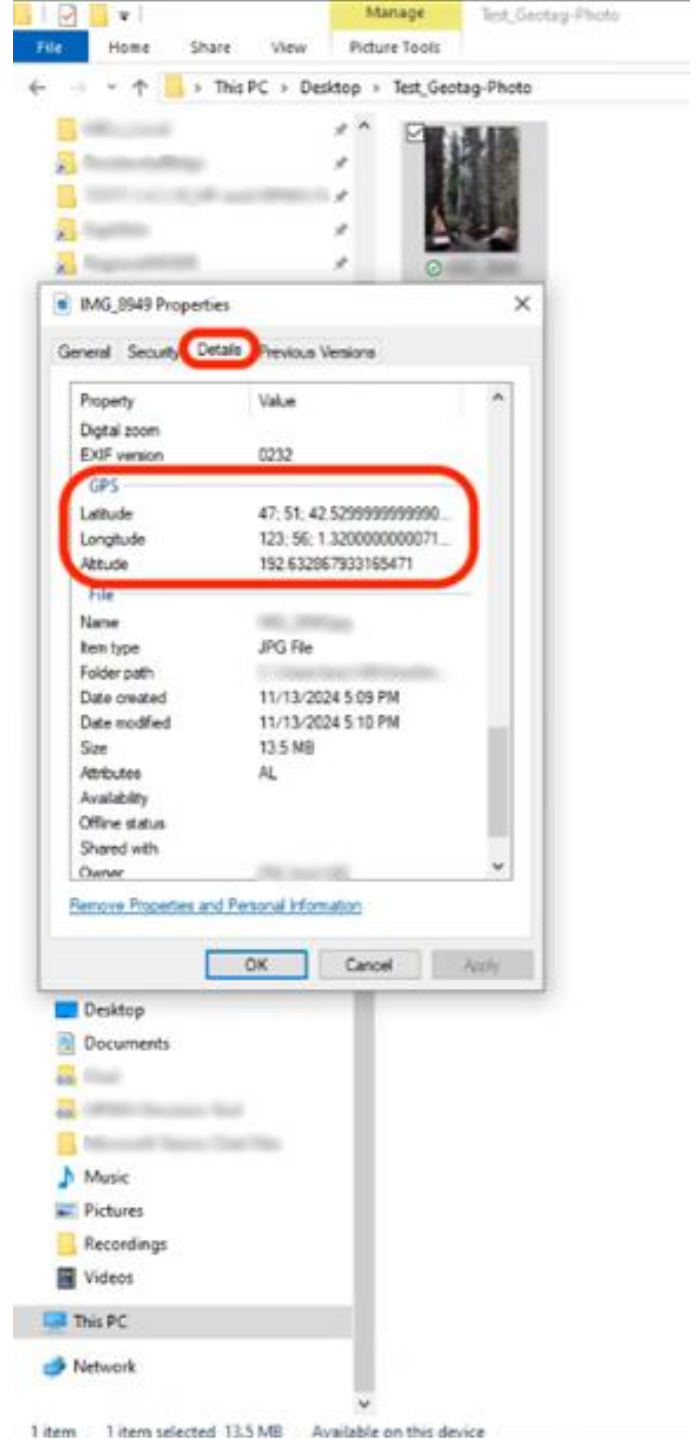
STEP 1 – WINDOWS

Once the photo is downloaded onto the computer, navigate to the file, right click it, and select “Properties.”



STEP 2 – WINDOWS

Once the photo's "Properties" page is expanded, navigate to "Details" and scroll down to view the image's geolocation information.



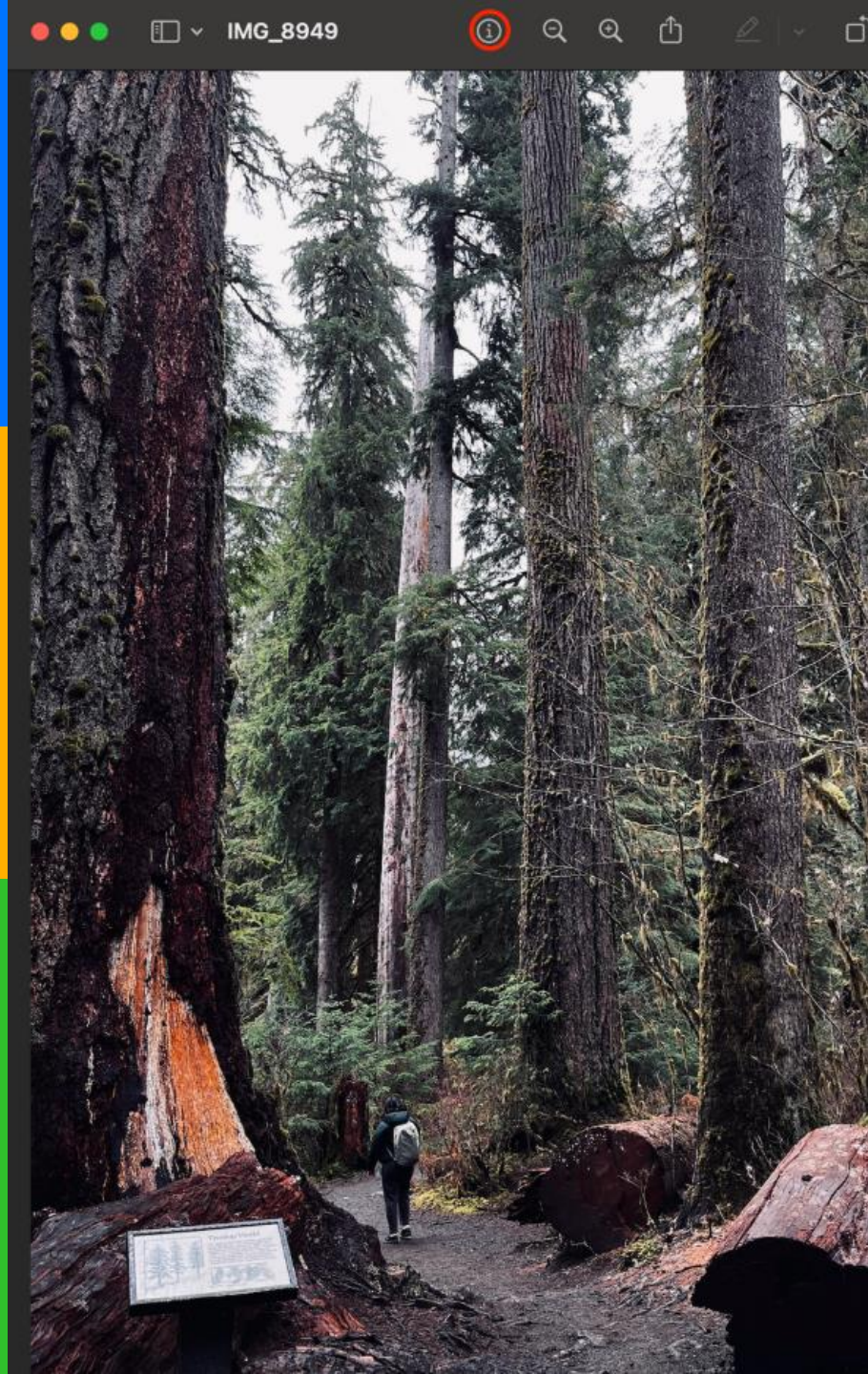


With Mac Computers

To view geotag data of downloaded photos, the following steps can be followed.

STEP 1 – MAC

Once the photo is downloaded onto the computer, open it in “Preview”, and click on the photo’s “Information” button.



STEP 2 – MAC

Once the photo's "Information" page is expanded, navigate to "More Info" button, and select "GPS" option to view the image's geolocation information.
