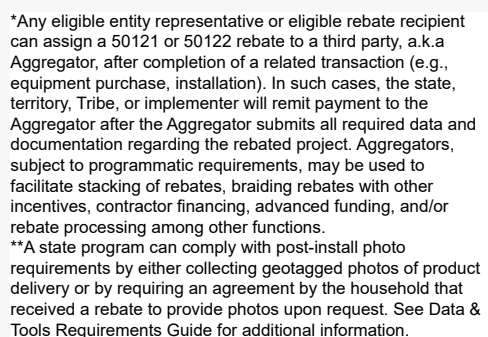




*Any eligible entity representative or eligible rebate recipient can assign a 50121 or 50122 rebate to a third party, a.k.a. an Aggregator, after completion of a related transaction (e.g., equipment purchase, installation). In such cases, the state, Territory, Tribe, or implementer will remit payment to the Aggregator after the Aggregator submits all required data and supporting documents to the responsible state or territory. Aggregators, subject to programmatic requirements, may be used to facilitate stacking of rebates, branding rebates with other incentives, contractor financing, advanced funding, and/or rebate processing among other functions.

**A state program can comply with post-install photo requirements by either collecting geotagged photos of product delivery and/or installation from the end user or household that received a rebate to provide photos upon request. See Data & Tools Requirements Guide for additional information.
