



\*Any eligible entity representative or eligible rebate recipient can assign a 50121 or 50122 rebate to a third party, a.k.a Aggregator, after completion of a related transaction (e.g., equipment purchase, installation). In such cases, the state or implementer will remit payment to the Aggregator after the Aggregator submits all required data and documentation regarding the rebated project. Aggregators, subject to programmatic requirements, may be used to facilitate stacking of rebates, braiding rebates with other incentives, contractor financing, advanced funding, and/or rebate processing among other functions.
